<p>Pre-med Prior to Vaccinations: We take every step possible to minimize the chance of an allergic reaction to vaccines. While the chances of a reaction are low, there is always a risk for your pet to react even if they have had no prior history or symptoms of a vaccine reaction. Ask us about your pet's risk level. We recommend a Diphenhydramine injection prior to vaccination to minimize the chance of reaction, or after a vaccine reaction to lessen its severity if they do react. Post vaccination pain medications are also available. Other medications or treatments may be needed if your pet has a vaccine reaction.</p>		
<p>Heartworm Prevention: Heartworm disease is caused by long slender worms that can reach up to 12 inches in length and live in the heart and adjoining vessels of infected pets. These parasites are transmitted by mosquitoes and are capable of causing substantial damage to the heart and lungs before the pet shows any sign of the disease. Fortunately, this disease is entirely preventable with bi-annual heartworm prevention injections (dogs only) or monthly medications. A heartworm test must be performed before prevention may be administered.</p>		
<p>Flea and Tick Prevention*: Parasites carry many diseases and cause discomfort to pets and people. We carry a complete line of products that have been shown to be the most effective at stopping flea infestations on your pet and in their environment (which is 95% of the problem). Ask us about which product is best suited for you and your pet. <i>*A flea control product will be administered to pets with live fleas. This makes your pet more comfortable and protects our hospital from possible flea infestation. When given, a charge will appear on your statement.</i></p>		
<p>Microchip: <u>10 million pets are lost each year and 80% of them are never found.</u> This radio transmitter technology helps identify your pet if they become lost or stolen and can increase the chance you will be reunited. The program includes lifetime registration and an emergency care guarantee should your pet become injured while separated from you (<i>Doctor discretion with very young or small pets</i>).</p>		
<p>Pedicure: Long nails can lead to discomfort for you and your pet as well as lead to damage of your home or property. While they are receiving care from us today we would be happy to trim your pet's nails for you. An additional charge also applies if restraint or sedation is required.</p>		
<p>Anal Gland Expression: These glands are found along the edge of the anus and contain a foul smelling liquid. They normally empty when the pet has a bowel movement. If your pet is licking, chewing or scooting their backside, these glands may be blocked and need to be manually emptied by a member of our medical team.</p>		
<p>Skin and Dental Care Products: Our GlenHaven® product lines can address all your pet's skin care needs from medicated shampoos and conditioners, to ear cleaners. Please ask about shampoos that will not wash off topical flea/tick treatments and can help improve dry, itchy and/or flaky skin. <p>Additional Surgical Services <i>Once the pre-anesthetic blood work results are in, we'll call you if any abnormalities are detected. If we cannot do the procedure due to abnormal results, the blood work will be charged separately with any discounts that apply.</i></p>		
<p>Post-operative Pain Medication: Injections are given to all surgery patients to control post-operative pain the day of the procedure. Medications for you to give your pet at home are also provided; additional charges apply.</p>	✓
